# Compliance to Traffic Rules for Student Safety

### **Dear Students and Parents**

At Bosco Public School, ensuring the safety of our students is our utmost priority. With this in mind, we would like to remind all students and parents of the importance of adhering to traffic rules, particularly when commuting to and from school.

We urge everyone to strictly follow the traffic regulations as per the norms set by the Delhi Transport Authorities.

Below are the key points that every student and parent must keep in mind:

• **Driving Without License**: It is strictly prohibited to operate any motor vehicle without a valid driving license. This applies to two-wheelers, cars, or any other motorized vehicle.(*Please note that our school discourage the students who commute using scooters, bikes or cars without driving license as it is not only unsafe but also punishable under the law.*)

## Do you know?

Offences by Juveniles-Where an offence under this Act has been committed by a juvenile, the guardian of such juvenile or the owner of the motor vehicle shall be deemed to be guilty. As per the Motor Vehicle Bill, 2019, "guardian/owner shall be deemed to be guilty and there will be a penalty of Rs 25,000 with 3-year imprisonment and cancellation of registration of the Motor Vehicle".

- **Helmet for Riders**: It is mandatory for the rider as well as**pillion rider**, including children, to wear a helmet while traveling on a two-wheeler. This rule is enforced for the safety of both the rider and the pillion.
- **Helmet and Guards for Bicycle Rider**:Bicycle riders to school must ensure to wear a helmet and the presence of proper safety gears.
- Obey Traffic Signals and Signs: One should adhere to traffic signals, signs, and road markings at all times. This includes stopping at red lights, yielding to pedestrians at zebra crossings, and following lane markings.
- **Avoid Distracted Driving**: Using mobile phones or engaging in any activity that diverts attention while driving or riding is strictly prohibited. Focus solely on the road to ensure safety.

We urge all parents to discuss these rules with their children and emphasize the importance of responsible behaviour on the roads. By working together and fostering a culture of safety consciousness, we can create a safer environment for everyone.
